To ensure that all fans have a pleasant game-day experience, each patron should act responsibly and be considerate of others. Unruly behavior will not be tolerated and, in some cases, may be deemed grounds for dismissal from the athletic facilities. These cases include, but are not limited to:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature.
- Any conduct deemed inappropriate or dangerous to fans, participants, or team members.
- Conduct that results in damage to the athletic facilities or other personal property.
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures.
- Interference with the progress of the game
- Failing to follow instructions of law enforcement

Verbal or physical harassment of opposing team fans.

- Unreasonably obstructing the view of other patrons.
- Offensive language or obscene gestures or to instigate, incite, or encourage a confrontation or physical assault.

EFISD Administration and security personnel reserve the right to deem an act or exhibited behavior as inappropriate and take action, based on available information and circumstances.
