



## **Elysian Fields Elementary Student Dress Code**

The District's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. The administration and faculty shall have the right to appraise any current fashion or fad and determine whether it is appropriate or inappropriate for school wear. The principal has the right to ask students to change attire if it is deemed inappropriate. Students who disregard the dress and grooming policy will be subject to disciplinary action. These rules are in effect at all school activities (whether on this campus or any other campus, or off campus at an official school related event) throughout the school year. Students who miss class time or who are sent home at any time while correcting grooming / dress code violations shall be considered absent or tardy. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following guidelines:

- Dress Attracting Undue Attention: Any form of dress that attracts undue attention, disrupts school or detracts from the learning process is not acceptable.
- No clothing shall be worn which advertises or depicts tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, substances prohibited by the District or political / social issues or propaganda.
- Shorts / dresses / skirts may be worn if they come below the student's fingertips while standing. (Buttocks must be covered at all times, including while standing, sitting, bending or reaching). No skin above the knee should show through sheer or distressed clothing. Tight fitting pants such as leggings, yoga pants, tights, jeggings, skinny jeans, etc. must be worn with a top that covers the bottom when sitting, standing, bending or reaching. This applies to all students. No skin showing above the knee.
- Blouses and shirts must COVER the shoulders (no strapless or thin "spaghetti" straps). Cleavage and tummies must be covered. Sheer garments or garments without a back are not allowed. No undergarments may show through outside clothing. This applies to all students.
- Pants must fit the waist line and not sag.
- Earrings may be worn, but only on the ear. Mouth grills are not allowed and all tattoos must be covered during school hours or during any school activities.
- Caps, hats, hoods, bandanas, and sunglasses may not be worn inside the building except on "special days" as designated by the campus or central administration. Caps, hats, bandanas, and sunglasses must remain in the backpack until the end of school.
- Hair must be clean and neat and not in a student's eyes. Only natural colored hair is allowed. Any hairstyle or color that, in the principal's judgment, causes disruption of or interference with normal school operations is prohibited.
- All students must keep their nails short and neat. No make-up or artificial eye lashes of any kind are to be worn by students on the elementary campus.
- No flip-flops, open-backed shoes, shoes with cleats, or roller skates may be worn.
